## Forecast Details

<b>TODAY</b>	Cloudy with scattered snow showers in the morning...Then snow likely in the afternoon. Snow accumulation 1 to 2 inches. Highs in the upper 20s to upper 30s...Coolest inland. Variable wind 10 mph except north 15 to 25 mph near seaward.
<b>TONIGHT</b>	Snow...Mixing with rain at Times along the coast. Snow accumulation 2 to 5 inches...Greatest north of moose pass. Lows in the mid teens to mid 30s...Coolest inland. Light winds except north and west wind 15 to 30 mph near seaward and whittier.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Snow ending in the morning. Additional snow accumulation up to 1 inch. Highs in the upper 20s to mid 30s. Northwest wind 10 to 15 mph except 15 to 30 mph near seaward and whittier.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. Lows 15 to 20 except in the mid 30s near seaward and whittier. Northwest wind 10 to 15 mph except 20 to 35 mph near seaward and whittier.
<b>TUESDAY</b>	Partly cloudy in the morning then becoming mostly cloudy. Highs in the upper 20s to upper 30s. Northwest wind 10 to 20 mph with local gusts to 40 mph in seaward and whittier.

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
