Forecast Details

TONIGHT	Snow. Snow accumulation 2 to 5 inches. Areas of snow and blowing snow will reduce visibilities under one mile at Times near seaward during the evening. Lows in the 20s to around 30. Variable wind to 10 mph. Near seaward...North wind 10 to 25 mph in the evening becoming light.
THANKSGIVING DAY	Numerous snow showers in the morning...Then snow and rain in the afternoon. Snow accumulation 1 to 4 inches. Highs in the 30s. Variable wind to 15 mph. Through portage valley and turnagain arm...East wind 5 to 20 mph increasing to 20 to 35 mph in the afternoon.
THURSDAY NIGHT	Snow and rain. Snow accumulation up to 5 inches. Lows in the mid 20s to mid 30s. Variable wind to 15 mph. Through portage valley and turnagain arm...Southeast wind 30 to 45 mph.
FRIDAY	Snow showers. Highs in the 30s. Variable wind to 10 mph. Through portage valley and turnagain arm...East wind 15 to 30 mph in the morning becoming light.
FRIDAY NIGHT	Mostly cloudy with a chance of snow showers. Lows in the 20s to around 30. Variable wind to 15 mph.
