<b>TONIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. Lows in the mid 50s. East winds 5 to 10 mph.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy. Slight chance of rain in the morning...Then rain likely in the afternoon. Highs in the lower 70s. East winds 10 to 15 mph becoming 5 to 15 mph with gusts to around 25 mph in the afternoon. Chance of rain 70 percent.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Tropical storm conditions possible. Rain. Rain May be heavy at Times. Near steady temperature in the lower 60s. Northeast winds 25 to 30 mph with gusts to around 40 mph becoming east 30 to 35 mph with gusts to around 50 mph after midnight. Chance of rain 90 percent.
<b>TUESDAY</b>	Tropical storm conditions possible. Mostly cloudy. Showers likely in the morning...Then chance of showers in the afternoon. Highs around 70. East winds 35 to 40 mph becoming northeast 40 to 45 mph in the afternoon. Gusts up to 55 mph. Chance of showers 70 percent.
<b>TUESDAY NIGHT</b>	Cooler. Mostly cloudy in the evening becoming partly cloudy. Slight chance of rain showers in the evening. Lows in the upper 40s. North winds 25 to 30 mph becoming 5 to 15 mph after midnight. Chance of showers 20 percent.
