<b>TONIGHT</b>	Partly cloudy in the evening...Becoming mostly cloudy. A slight chance of rain...Showers and thunderstorms after midnight. Lows in the upper 40s. South winds 5 to 10 mph. The chance of precipitation 20 percent after midnight.
<b>SUNDAY</b>	A chance of showers...Thunderstorms and rain in the morning...Then showers and thunderstorms likely in the afternoon. Highs in the mid 60s. South winds 5 to 10 mph. The chance of precipitation 40 percent in the morning...Increasing to 70 percent in the afternoon. Average rainfall less than 1/10 inch.
<b>SUNDAY NIGHT</b>	Showers and thunderstorms likely. Lows in the mid 40s. Southwest winds 5 to 10 mph in the evening...Becoming north 10 to 15 mph after midnight. The chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy. Cooler. A chance of showers and thunderstorms in the morning...Then a slight chance of showers and thunderstorms in the afternoon. Highs in the mid 50s. North winds 10 to 15 mph. The chance of precipitation 50 percent in the morning...Decreasing to 20 percent in the afternoon.
