TONIGHT

Partly cloudy. Lows 32 to 42 at 5000 feet...23 to 33 at 8000 feet.

FRIDAY

Mostly cloudy. A 50 percent chance of rain and snow in the afternoon. Near the crest...A 50 percent chance of snow in the afternoon. Windy. Snow level 7000 feet. Highs 53 to 61 at 5000 feet...39 to 49 at 8000 feet. South winds 25 to 30 mph. Gusts up to 50 mph in the afternoon.

FRIDAY NIGHT

Snow and rain likely in the evening...Then snow showers likely after midnight. Near the crest...Snow likely in the evening...Then snow showers likely after midnight. Chance of precipitation 70 percent. Breezy. Snow accumulation up to 3 inches. Lows 31 to 39 at 5000 feet...20 to 28 at 8000 feet. Southeast winds around 25 mph with gusts to around 40 mph in the evening.

SATURDAY

Mostly cloudy with a slight chance of snow showers. Windy. Highs 42 to 50 at 5000 feet...30 to 40 at 8000 feet. Northeast winds 25 to 30 mph.

SATURDAY NIGHT

Mostly clear. Very windy. Colder. Lows 23 to 33 at 5000 feet...13 to 23 at 8000 feet. Northeast winds 30 to 45 mph with gusts to around 75 mph.
