<b>TONIGHT</b>	Partly cloudy in the evening then becoming mostly cloudy. Lows 30 to 40. South winds 10 to 15 mph.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Overcast. A slight chance of rain and snow in the morning...Then snow and rain in the afternoon. Cooler. Highs 34 to 44 higher elevations...43 to 53 lower elevations. Snow accumulation up to 3 inches. Snow level 6000 feet Decreasing to 4500 feet in the afternoon. South winds 10 to 15 mph with local gusts to around 45 mph.
<b>FRIDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. Snow showers and rain showers likely in the evening...Then a chance of rain and snow showers after midnight. Windy...Colder. Lows 20 to 30 higher elevations...28 to 36 lower elevations. Snow accumulation 2 to 4 inches. Total snow accumulation 4 to 7 inches. Snow level 4500 feet. Southwest winds around 10 mph with local gusts to around 35 mph...Becoming northeast 20 to 30 mph with higher gusts after midnight.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Partly to mostly cloudy. A slight chance of showers. Windy. Highs 31 to 41 higher elevations...43 to 53 lower elevations. Snow level 4500 feet.
