





<b>MONDAY</b>	Partly cloudy in the morning...Then mostly cloudy with a chance of rain and isolated thunderstorms in the afternoon. Highs around 77. East winds 10 to 15 mph. Chance of rain 50 percent.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Rain likely and isolated thunderstorms in the evening...Then rain and isolated thunderstorms after midnight. Lows around 64. Some thunderstorms May produce heavy rainfall. East winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts to around 30 mph. Chance of rain 80 percent.
<b>TUESDAY</b>	Rain and isolated thunderstorms in the morning...Then rain likely and chance of thunderstorms in the afternoon. Highs around 74. Some thunderstorms May produce heavy rainfall. South winds 15 to 20 mph. Chance of rain 80 percent.
<b>TUESDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy with a chance of showers and thunderstorms in the evening...Then partly cloudy with a slight chance of showers and thunderstorms after midnight. Lows around 55. Southwest winds 15 to 20 mph shifting to the west after midnight. Gusts up to 30 mph. Chance of rain 40 percent.
