<b>REST OF TONIGHT</b>	Tropical storm conditions possible. Cloudy. Slight chance of showers late in the evening...Then chance of showers after midnight. Lows in the upper 60s. East winds 10 to 20 mph increasing to 20 to 30 mph with gusts to around 40 mph late. Chance of showers 50 percent.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Tropical storm conditions expected with hurricane conditions possible. Showers. Locally heavy rainfall possible. Highs in the lower 70s. Northeast winds 30 to 35 mph with gusts to around 50 mph. Chance of showers near 100 percent.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Tropical storm conditions expected with hurricane conditions possible. Showers in the evening...Then showers likely after midnight. Locally heavy rainfall possible. Lows 60 to 66. North winds 30 to 45 mph with gusts to around 60 mph. Chance of showers near 100 percent.
<b>TUESDAY</b>	Tropical storm conditions expected with hurricane conditions possible. Cloudy in the morning then becoming partly cloudy. A 20 percent chance of showers. Highs in the lower 70s. North winds 15 to 30 mph. Gusts up to 45 mph Decreasing to 35 mph in the afternoon.
