






## Forecast Details

<b>TONIGHT</b>	Tropical storm conditions possible with hurricane conditions also possible. Cloudy. Slight chance of showers in the evening...Then chance of showers after midnight. Near steady temperature in the upper 60s. East winds 20 to 30 mph. Chance of showers 50 percent.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Tropical storm conditions expected with hurricane conditions possible. Showers. Locally heavy rainfall possible. Highs in the lower 70s. Northeast winds 25 to 35 mph. Gusts up to 40 mph increasing to 50 mph in the afternoon. Chance of showers near 100 percent.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Tropical storm conditions possible with hurricane conditions also possible. Showers in the evening...Then showers likely after midnight. Locally heavy rainfall possible. Lows 60 to 66. North winds 25 to 40 mph with gusts to around 55 mph. Chance of showers near 100 percent.
<b>TUESDAY</b>	Hurricane conditions possible. Cloudy in the morning then becoming partly cloudy. A 20 percent chance of showers. Highs in the lower 70s. North winds 15 to 30 mph. Gusts up to 40 mph in the morning.

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
