<b>TODAY</b>	Areas of dense fog this morning. Partly sunny. Highs in the upper 40s. Northwest winds 10 to 15 mph.
<b>TONIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy with a chance of rain showers. Snow showers likely...Mainly after midnight. Snow accumulation up to 1 inch. Breezy with lows in the lower 30s. Northwest winds 20 to 25 mph. Gusts up to 45 mph...Increasing to 55 mph after midnight. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Snow showers likely. A chance of rain showers in the afternoon. Snow accumulation up to 1 inch possible. Blustery and cooler. Near steady temperature in the mid 30s. Northwest winds 20 to 25 mph with gusts up to 55 mph. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>FRIDAY NIGHT</b>	Partly cloudy. A chance of snow showers in the evening. Little or no snow accumulation. Blustery with lows in the mid 20s. Northwest winds 15 to 25 mph with gusts up to 50 mph. Chance of snow 40 percent.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Sunny. Not as cool with highs around 50. West winds 15 to 20 mph. Gusts up to 35 mph in the morning.
