Very windy with lows in the upper 20s. Northwest winds 25 to 35 mph. Gusts up to 50 mph...Increasing to 60 mph. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	A chance of rain showers. Snow showers likely...Mainly in the morning. Snow accumulation up to 1 inch. Windy with highs in the upper 30s. Northwest winds 20 to 30 mph with gusts up to 60 mph. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>FRIDAY NIGHT</b>	Partly cloudy with a chance of snow showers in the evening...Then mostly clear after midnight. Breezy with lows in the upper 20s. Northwest winds 20 to 25 mph with gusts up to 45 mph. Chance of snow 40 percent.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Sunny. Not as cool with highs in the lower 50s. West winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts up to 35 mph.
<b>SATURDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly clear. Lows in the lower 30s. West winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph.
