<b>TONIGHT</b>	Rain mixed with snow will change to all snow later tonight. Snow accumulations around an inch...Except 3 to 6 inches at Elevations above 2000 feet. Breezy with lows in the lower 30s. Northwest winds 15 to 25 mph with gusts up to 35 mph. Chance of precipitation 100 percent.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Snow mixed with rain in the morning...Then snow snow showers likely in the afternoon. Additional snow accumulation up to 1 inch. Highs in the mid 30s. Northwest winds 15 to 25 mph with gusts up to 35 mph. Chance of precipitation 80 percent.
<b>SATURDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. Lows in the mid 20s. Northwest winds 15 to 20 mph.
<b>SUNDAY</b>	Partly sunny. Highs in the upper 30s. Northwest winds 10 to 15 mph.
<b>SUNDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. A chance of rain or snow showers after midnight. Lows in the upper 20s. West winds around 10 mph in the evening...Becoming light and variable. Chance of precipitation 50 percent.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Rain or snow showers likely. Highs in the upper 30s. Chance of rain 70 percent.
