<b>TONIGHT</b>	Rain...Mainly after midnight. Patchy fog. Lows in the lower 40s. Light and variable winds...Becoming north around 5 mph after midnight. Chance of rain near 100 percent.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Rain. Patchy fog. Near steady temperature around 40. North winds 5 to 10 mph...Becoming northwest in the afternoon. Gusts up to 25 mph. Chance of rain near 100 percent.
<b>FRIDAY NIGHT</b>	Cloudy. Rain and snow likely...Mainly in the evening. Patchy fog. Little or no snow accumulation. Near steady temperature in the upper 30s. West winds 15 to 20 mph. Gusts up to 30 mph...Increasing to 50 mph after midnight. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy with a chance of rain in the morning... Then mostly sunny in the afternoon. Blustery with highs in the mid 40s. Northwest winds 15 to 25 mph. Gusts up to 50 mph... Decreasing to 40 mph in the afternoon. Chance of rain 50 percent.
<b>SATURDAY NIGHT</b>	Partly cloudy in the evening...Then becoming mostly clear. Lows in the upper 20s. West winds 10 to 15 mph.
