



<b>TONIGHT</b>	Rain showers. Near steady temperature in the mid 30s. Northwest winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 45 mph. Chance of rain 90 percent.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Cloudy with a chance of rain showers in the morning... Then mostly sunny in the afternoon. Highs in the lower 40s. Northwest winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts up to 45 mph. Chance of rain 50 percent.
<b>SATURDAY NIGHT</b>	Partly cloudy. Lows in the upper 20s. West winds 10 to 15 mph. Gusts up to 35 mph...Decreasing to 20 mph after midnight.
<b>SUNDAY</b>	Mostly sunny. Highs in the upper 40s. West winds 5 to 10 mph. Gusts up to 20 mph in the afternoon.
<b>SUNDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. Lows in the lower 30s. Southwest winds 5 to 10 mph...Becoming south after midnight.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Rain showers likely...Mainly in the afternoon. Highs in the lower 40s. Chance of rain 70 percent.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. A chance of rain and snow showers in the evening...Then a chance of snow showers after midnight. Lows in the upper 20s. Chance of precipitation 40 percent.
