<b>TONIGHT</b>	Cloudy. A slight chance of drizzle this evening...Then rain likely after midnight. Areas of fog. Lows in the mid 30s. Light and variable winds. Chance of rain 70 percent.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Rain. Rain May be heavy at Times. Highs around 40. North winds around 10 mph. Chance of rain near 100 percent.
<b>FRIDAY NIGHT</b>	Rain or snow in the evening...Tapering off to snow showers late. Snow accumulation of 2 to 4 inches...Mainly above 2000 feet. Lows 30 to 35. Northwest winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph. Chance of precipitation near 100 percent.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy with a snow showers likely...Mainly in the morning. A chance of rain or snow showers in the afternoon. Little or no additional snow accumulation. Highs 35 to 40. Northwest winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts up to 35 mph. Chance of precipitation 60 percent.
<b>SATURDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. A chance of snow showers in the evening. Lows in the lower 20s. West winds 10 to 15 mph. Chance of snow 40 percent.
