<b>TONIGHT</b>	Partly cloudy in the evening then becoming mostly cloudy. Lows 24 to 34. Southwest winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Slight chance of rain and snow in the morning...Then snow and rain likely in the afternoon. Snow level 6000 feet lowering to 5000 feet. Snow accumulation up to 2 inches. Highs 45 to 55. Southwest winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 30 mph.
<b>FRIDAY NIGHT</b>	Snow and rain in the evening...Then chance of snow showers after midnight. Snow level 5000 feet lowering to the valley floor. Additional snow accumulation up to 4 inches. Lows 22 to 32. North winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 30 mph.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy. Chance of showers in the morning... Then slight chance of snow showers in the afternoon. Highs 34 to 44. Northeast winds 10 to 15 mph. Gusts up to 30 mph in the afternoon.
<b>SATURDAY NIGHT</b>	Partly cloudy. Lows 14 to 24. Northeast winds 10 to 15 mph.
