<b>TONIGHT</b>	Mainly clear. Lows ranging from the lower 30s near lake erie to the upper 20s well inland. South winds 10 to 15 mph diminishing to 10 mph or less.
<b>SUNDAY</b>	Mostly sunny in the morning...Then increasing clouds. A chance of showers late in the day. Not as cold with highs in the upper 40s to lower 50s. South winds 10 to 15 mph becoming southwest. Chance of rain 30 percent.
<b>SUNDAY NIGHT</b>	Showers. Lows in the upper 30s. South winds 10 to 20 mph...Becoming west. Chance of rain 90 percent.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy. A chance of rain and snow showers in the morning...Then snow showers likely with a chance of rain showers in the afternoon. Colder with highs around 40. Northwest winds 10 to 20 mph. Chance of precipitation 60 percent.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Snow and rain showers likely in the evening...Then a chance of snow showers overnight. Lows in the upper 20s. Northwest winds 10 to 20 mph...Becoming west. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
