<b>TODAY</b>	Cloudy. A chance of showers from late morning on. Highs in the upper 40s. South winds 10 to 15 mph...Becoming southwest 10 mph or less. Chance of rain 40 percent.
<b>TONIGHT</b>	Rain showers likely in the evening...Then snow and rain showers likely overnight. Accumulation an inch or less. Lows in the lower 30s. Southwest winds 10 mph or less. Chance of precipitation 60 percent.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Snow and rain showers. Accumulation an inch or less. Colder with highs in the upper 30s. Southwest winds 10 mph or less... Becoming northwest 10 to 20 mph. Chance of precipitation 80 percent.
<b>FRIDAY NIGHT</b>	Snow and rain showers likely in the evening...Then snow showers likely overnight. An inch or so accumulation possible over the higher elevations. Lows around 30. Northwest winds 15 to 25 mph. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Cloudy in the morning...Then becoming partly sunny. A chance of snow and rain showers. Highs in the upper 30s. Northwest winds 10 to 20 mph...Becoming west. Chance of precipitation 40 percent.
