<b>TODAY</b>	Areas of dense fog in the morning...With visibility one quarter mile or less at Times. Otherwise...Mostly cloudy with a chance of showers...Mainly late in the afternoon. Highs in the lower 50s. Southwest winds 5 to 10 mph. Chance of rain 40 percent.
<b>TONIGHT</b>	Rain showers likely in the evening...Changing to snow showers after midnight. Snow accumulation of a coating to one inch possible...Mainly across the higher terrain. Lows in the lower 30s. West winds 5 to 10 mph. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Cloudy...And becoming windy. Snow showers likely...Mainly in the morning. Little or no additional snow accumulation. Highs around 40. West winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts up to 35 mph. Chance of snow 70 percent.
<b>FRIDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy and windy with a 50 percent chance of snow showers. Lows in the lower 30s. West winds 20 to 25 mph with gusts up to 45 mph.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy in the morning...Then becoming partly sunny. Continued windy with highs in the lower 40s. West winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts up to 35 mph.
