






<b>TONIGHT</b>	Cloudy with a 20 percent chance of rain. Warmer. Lows in the upper 50s. Southeast winds 5 to 10 mph.
<b>SUNDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy. A slight chance of rain and isolated thunderstorms in the morning...Then a chance of rain and isolated thunderstorms in the afternoon. Highs in the mid 70s. South winds 5 to 10 mph. Chance of rain 20 percent in the morning increasing to 30 percent in the afternoon.
<b>SUNDAY NIGHT</b>	Cloudy. A chance of rain and isolated thunderstorms in the evening...Then showers and thunderstorms after midnight. Lows in the mid 50s. South winds 5 to 10 mph. Chance of rain 50 percent in the evening increasing to 90 percent after midnight.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Showers and thunderstorms in the morning...Then showers and scattered thunderstorms in the afternoon. Cooler. Highs in the mid 50s. Temperature steady or slowly falling in the afternoon. North winds 10 to 15 mph. Chance of rain 80 percent.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Showers likely. Colder. Lows in the lower 40s. Northeast winds 10 to 15 mph. Chance of rain 70 percent.
