SATURDAY NIGHT	Partly cloudy before midnight then becoming cloudy. Areas of fog after midnight. Warmer. Lows in the lower 60s. Southeast winds 5 to 10 mph.
SUNDAY	Mostly cloudy. Areas of fog in the morning. Slight chance of showers in the morning...Then a slight chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms in the afternoon. Highs in the upper 70s. Southeast winds 10 to 15 mph. Chance of rain 20 percent.
SUNDAY NIGHT	Cloudy with showers likely and isolated thunderstorms. Lows in the lower 50s. East winds 5 to 10 mph increasing to north 15 mph with gusts to around 25 mph after midnight. Chance of rain 70 percent.
MONDAY	Showers. Much cooler. Highs in the upper 50s. Temperature steady or slowly falling in the afternoon. Chance of rain 90 percent.
