



Forecast Details

TONIGHT	Rain with snow above 1500 feet until midnight...Then snow all areas. Snow accumulation of 2 to 4 inches...Mainly in the higher elevations. Lows in the lower to mid 30s. Northwest winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts up to 40 mph. Chance of precipitation near 100 percent.
SATURDAY	Mostly cloudy. Rain or snow showers likely...Mainly in the morning. Total snow accumulation of 3 to 6 inches in the higher elevations. Breezy with highs in the mid 30s. Northwest winds 15 to 25 mph with gusts up to 35 mph. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
SATURDAY NIGHT	Mostly cloudy until midnight...Then becoming partly cloudy. Lows in the upper 20s. Northwest winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph.
SUNDAY	Partly sunny. Highs in the upper 30s. West winds around 10 mph.
SUNDAY NIGHT	Cloudy. Snow showers likely after midnight. Light snow accumulation possible. Lows in the mid 20s. Light and variable winds. Chance of snow 60 percent.
