



| SATURDAY | Cloudy with a chance of rain or snow showers in the morning...Then partly sunny with a slight chance of rain or snow showers in the afternoon. Windy with highs in the upper 30s. Northwest winds 15 to 25 mph with gusts up to 45 mph. Chance of precipitation 50 percent. |
| SATURDAY NIGHT | Partly cloudy. Lows in the upper 20s. West winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph. |
| SUNDAY | Partly sunny. Highs in the lower 40s. West winds around 10 mph. |
