TONIGHT

Rain and snow. Snow level 7000 feet. East wind in the near 10 mph.

THANKSGIVING DAY

Rain and snow. Snow level 6500 feet. Afternoon pass temperatures in the upper 30s. Variable wind in the passes to 10 mph.

THURSDAY NIGHT

Rain and snow. Snow level 5500 feet. Snow accumulation up to 2 inches. East wind in the passes near 10 mph becoming west.

FRIDAY

Showers likely in the morning then mostly cloudy with a chance of afternoon showers. Snow level 2500 feet. Afternoon pass temperatures in the mid 30s. West wind in the passes near 15 mph.

FRIDAY NIGHT

Cloudy with a chance of rain or snow. Snow level 2000 feet. West wind in the passes 15 to 20 mph.

SATURDAY

Snow with rain likely. Snow level 2500 feet. Afternoon pass temperatures in the lower 30s.

SATURDAY NIGHT

Rain and snow likely. Snow level 3500 feet.
