







## Forecast Details

<b>TONIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. Isolated showers in the evening...Then a slight chance of rain overnight. Snow level 4000 feet rising to 5000 feet after midnight. Local snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches this evening. Valley lows around 40. Southeast wind 5 to 15 mph.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Rain. Snow level 4500 feet. Snow accumulation of 3 to 6 inches. Valley highs 45 to 50. South wind 10 to 20 mph. Gusts to 30 mph ridges in the morning.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Showers. Snow level 4500 feet. Snow accumulation of 2 to 5 inches. Valley lows around 40. South wind 5 to 15 mph.
<b>TUESDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy. Rain and snow showers likely in the morning...Then a chance of rain and snow showers in the afternoon. Snow level 3500 feet. Valley highs 45 to 50. South wind 5 to 15 mph.
<b>TUESDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. A chance of showers in the evening... Then a chance of rain after midnight. Snow level 4000 feet. Valley lows 35 to 40. South wind 5 to 10 mph.
