<b>TONIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. Scattered rain or snow showers in the evening...Then a slight chance of rain or snow showers overnight. Snow level 3000 feet. Lows in the 30s. Chance of precipitation 40 percent.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Mostly cloudy. A chance of rain or snow in the afternoon. Snow level 3500 feet. Highs in the mid to upper 40s. Chance of precipitation 40 percent.
<b>MONDAY NIGHT</b>	Cloudy. Rain and mountain snow in the evening... Then a chance of rain and mountain snow overnight. Mountain snow accumulation up to 1 inch above 4500 feet. Lows in the upper 20s to mid 30s. Chance of precipitation 80 percent.
<b>TUESDAY</b>	Partly sunny. A slight chance of rain and mountain snow showers in the morning...Then a slight chance of mountain snow showers in the afternoon. Snow level 4000 feet. Highs in the mid to upper 40s. Chance of precipitation 20 percent.
<b>TUESDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy. A slight chance of snow showers in the evening...Then a slight chance of snow overnight. Lows in the mid 20s to lower 30s. Chance of precipitation 20 percent.
