SATURDAY

Cloudy. Snow and rain likely north with a chance of rain and snow south. Snow level 3000 feet rising to 5500 feet late Saturday night. Total snow accumulation 3 to 8 inches far north tapering to less than 2 inches south. Afternoon pass temperatures in the 30s. West wind in the passes 5 to 15 mph.

SATURDAY NIGHT

Cloudy. Snow and rain likely north with a chance of rain and snow south. Snow level 3000 feet rising to 5500 feet late Saturday night. Total snow accumulation 3 to 8 inches far north tapering to less than 2 inches south. Afternoon pass temperatures in the 30s. West wind in the passes 5 to 15 mph.

SUNDAY

Mostly cloudy with a chance of rain or snow. Snow level 6500 feet. Afternoon pass temperatures in the mid to upper 30s. West wind in the passes near 10 mph becoming east.

SUNDAY NIGHT

Mostly cloudy. Widespread valley fog. Freezing level 8000 feet. East wind in the passes 10 to 15 mph.
