REST OF TONIGHT	Rain and mountain snow. Mountain snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches above 4500 feet. Lows in the lower to mid 30s. Chance of precipitation 90 percent.
FRIDAY	Cloudy with rain and mountain snow in the morning... Then partly sunny with a chance of rain and mountain snow in the afternoon. Mountain snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches. Snow level 4000 feet in the morning...Lowering to 3000 feet in the afternoon. Highs in the upper 30s to lower 40s. Chance of precipitation 80 percent.
FRIDAY NIGHT	Mostly cloudy. A chance of snow in the evening. Areas of fog overnight. Lows in the 20s. Chance of precipitation 20 percent.
SATURDAY	Cloudy. Areas of fog in the morning. A slight chance of snow in the morning...Then a slight chance of rain or snow in the afternoon. Snow level 2500 feet in the afternoon. Highs in the mid to upper 30s. Chance of precipitation 20 percent.
SATURDAY NIGHT	Mostly cloudy with a 20 percent chance of snow. Areas of fog overnight. Lows in the upper 20s to lower 30s.
