TODAY	Mostly cloudy this morning...Then becoming partly sunny. Highs in the lower 40s. West winds 5 to 10 mph.
TONIGHT	Mostly cloudy with a chance of rain showers. Snow showers likely...Mainly after midnight. Snow accumulation around an inch. Lows in the lower 30s. Northwest winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
FRIDAY	Snow showers in the morning...Then snow and rain showers likely in the afternoon. Areas of blowing snow. Additional snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches. Total snow accumulation 1 to 5 inches. Windy and cooler. Near steady temperature around 30. Northwest winds 15 to 25 mph. Gusts up to 40 mph in the afternoon. Chance of precipitation 90 percent.
FRIDAY NIGHT	Mostly cloudy with a 50 percent chance of snow showers. Areas of blowing snow. Brisk and cold with lows in the mid 20s. Northwest winds 15 to 20 mph.
SATURDAY	Partly sunny. Not as cool with highs in the lower 40s. Northwest winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph.
