<b>TONIGHT</b>	Cloudy. Snow and rain showers likely...Mainly after midnight. Snow accumulation up to 1 inch. Lows in the lower 30s. West winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts up to 40 mph. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Snow showers likely. A chance of rain showers in the afternoon. Snow accumulation around an inch possible. Cooler. Near steady temperature in the mid 30s. West winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts up to 40 mph. Chance of precipitation 70 percent.
<b>FRIDAY NIGHT</b>	Mostly cloudy with a 50 percent chance of snow showers. Little or no additional snow accumulation. Lows in the mid 20s. Northwest winds 15 to 20 mph with gusts up to 35 mph.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Mostly sunny. A chance of snow showers in the morning. Not as cool with highs in the mid 40s. West winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 30 mph. Chance of snow 30 percent.
